

# Worship Team Building Plan

**Objective:** Submission to God in Unity

**Inspiration:** Jeremiah 1:10

- Sometimes you have to tear it down to rebuild it.

**Approach:** Spring Cleaning (Parable)

- Pull everything out of the cabinets
- Shine a light in the dark corners to clean the dust & cobwebs
- Wash each dish (remove the dust & sanitize)
- Evaluate each dish (Aspects of Modern Worship Ministry)
  - Do I need it? Should I keep it?
    - The dish that hasn't been touched since *last* spring cleaning (get rid of it?)
    - The whisk that's gotten jammed in the drawer so many times it's now bent, useless & needs replaced
    - The dish I forgot I had but is super useful. (will I use it?)
    - The dish I forgot to return to my neighbor (give it back!)
    - The dish that I have no clue what it is or where it came from.
- Organize (What *our* model of Worship Ministry should look like)
  - Put it back together
  - Make places for the things used often
  - Make places for the things used less often
  - Save room for the things we realize we need but are missing.

**Get in the Word:**

- The very foundation of all that we do is rooted in God's Word
- Over the next several weeks we will work together as a team to take a deep dive into Scriptural Worship.
  - Interactive study insights, real-world application examples, Inputs & general team comradery encouraged.
  - We will set time goals (I.e. no later than 7pm on Thursdays) and pick up where we left off the following week. (No stress, No pressure – Let it soak in).
  - We will make room for the Spirit and go where He leads.
- These studies will give us the solid foundation stones of God's word.
- *Then*, as a team, we'll use those foundation stones together to build & model what our worship team will be & look like moving forward.

# Practical Lesson Plan

(Note, some studies may take more than 1 week to complete)

1.  Bible Study: **(The Body of Christ)** Who are we as people?
  - a. Understanding each unique personality, challenge & how to navigate those
  - b. Personality Quiz & Review.
  
2. Bible Study: **(The Rejected Worship)**
  - a. Yes, God does reject worship, He doesn't just accept whatever is given
  - b. Scriptures: **1 Kings 12:25-33, Matthew 7:21, Amos 4 & 5**
  
3. Bible Study: **(The First Worship Leader)**
  - a. The start of corrupted worship & spiritual warfare (Pride was at the heart of this)
  - b. Scriptures: **Isaiah 14:12-15, Ezekiel 28:12-17, 1 Chronicles 21:1, Matthew 4:1-11, Ephesians 2:1-10, 1 Samuel 15**, (We will mention afflictions of Job, but won't read the book together)
  
4. Bible Study: **(Pride)**
  - a. How does the Bible describe Pride?
  - b. How does Pride feed on different personality types?
  - c. Scriptures: **Proverbs 16:1-9 & 16-18, Obadiah 1:3-4, Galatians 6:1-3, James 4:1-6, Proverbs 8:13, Mark 7:17-23, 1 John 2:15-17, Daniel 4:28-33, Luke 18:9-14, Proverbs 13:1 & 10, Philippians 2:1-11**
  
5. Bible Study: **(Praise is a Weapon)**
  - a. Is Praise a Weapon?
  - b. The Science of Music (don't shoot yourself in the foot!)
  - c. Scriptures: **2 Chronicles 20:1-3, Joshua 6:1-21, 1 Samuel 16:14-23, 2 Kings 3:1-19, Psalm 22:3, Acts 16:16-26, Isaiah 30:27-33**
  
6. Handout: **Judging by the Fruit**
  - a. Understanding "Spiritual" fruit vs. "Earthly" Fruit.
  - b. Scripture: **Matthew 7:16-18, Galatians 5:22-23, Matthew 7: 22**
  
7. Bible Study: **(Hebrew Word Study: Praise, Worship & Sacrifice)**
  - a. What color & context can we gain from understanding the Hebrew words used in the original text?
  - b. Introduction to "what is Praise, Worship & Sacrifice" as listed in the Bible.
  - c. Scriptures: **Psalm 22, Psalm 150, 2 Samuel 6:12-15, Psalm 34:1-7, Psalm 138:1-3, Isaiah 61:1-3, Psalm 103:1-5, Genesis 22:1-5, Exodus 3:11-12, Joshua 24:14-15, Psalm 33:8-9, Exodus 23:18-19, Psalm 51:14-17, Genesis 4:3-5, Malachi 1:6-14, Leviticus 1:3-9, Psalm 107:17-22**
